Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for all your positive feedback regarding the 'Home Learning'. I have shared these with staff and governors. Should you have any questions or ideas regarding how these can be further developed please phone or email me at school. Thank you also the parents who have taken time to do this already.

To ensure that children are able to access weekly learning, we will continue with the development of videos and learning links to all year groups.

In addition to this we would like to be able to communicate more with individual children and families. The next steps are to introduce emails creating virtual classrooms. This will enable families to share learning with teachers. Teachers can scan provide some feedback and next steps for learning where appropriate.

Our aim is that this will enable staff to reconnect on a one to one with each child, remotely guiding learning. Clear personalisation will be evident, further motivating our children.

This is accessed through the home page on Purple Mash and provides a huge amount of books and accompanying reading activities to extend reading and comprehension strategies.
