As soon as we have undertaken a full risk assessment considering the specific issues relating to our school site and community, we will send further communication to inform parents and carers of the steps that we will be taking to maintain high levels safety for children and staff.

We understand how important it is that parents and families are informed about the availability of child care/wrap around provision and will aim to let you know about this as soon as possible.

We are all really keen and excited to welcome the children back into school and to see normality returning.

We will be asking for ideas from parents and the school community in the future...


