### Important information regarding Nursery places at Great Moor Infant School

Firstly we hope this information finds you well and you and your families are safe and in good health.

We would like to offer you a very warm welcome to Great Moor Infant School and our Nursery class. The beginning of your child's time at Nursery is exciting and very special. We look forward to meeting you and your child in September.

Initially we would like to take this opportunity to inform you about Nursery places and timings. The Nursery hours are 15 hours per week in school term time. We currently do not offer additional hours, the 30 hours that some families are initialled to can be topped up by using childminders or other Nursery settings.

#### Option 1

##### 2.5 days per week (start of the week)

- Your child may attend Monday-Wednesday
- This would incorporate your child staying for their lunch (you are required to provide a picnic packed lunch)
- Timings would be from 9.00am and children will be collected by 3pm on Monday and Tuesday, and start at 8.30 and be collected by 11.30am on Wednesdays

#### Option 2

##### 2.5 days per week (end of the week)

- Your child may attend Wednesday-Friday
- This would incorporate your child staying for their lunch (you are required to provide a picnic packed lunch)
- Timings on Wednesday would be from 12.30 on until 3.30pm
- Thursday and Friday timings will be from 9.00am and children will be collected by 3pm

Please indicate if you are taking up the place at our Nursery and your first preference between option 1 and option 2. Email the Nursery staff, providing your child's name and your preferred option - [nursery@greatmoor-inf.stockport.sch.uk](mailto:nursery@greatmoor-inf.stockport.sch.uk)

\*If you do not wish to take up the place at the Nursery for what ever reason please let us know as soon as possible.



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Nursery staff will be able to communicate with you through email and can get your child's place confirmed in a designated session.

Usually as part of transition, our nursery team would endeavour to visit your child within their current setting, however, unfortunately this summer it will not be possible. We will also not be participating in home visits in September. We will be contacting other settings via the phone, email or zoom.

However, it is very important to us that you and your child will recognise and feel familiar with the Nursery staff and so we are currently working on ideas and over the next few weeks will be creating virtual tours of the Nursery and staff will be introducing themselves and reading stories for you and your child. All information regarding communication with you will be added to the school website as it becomes available. Please keep checking the website before the summer break.
