# NURSERY

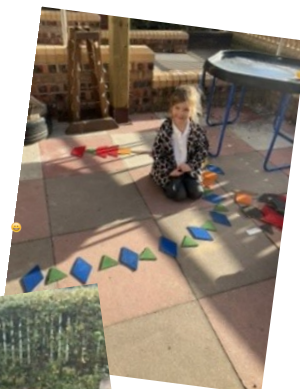
We have started to do dough disco each day... It is brilliant for developing hand strength!

We've been having lots of fun with our Maths!



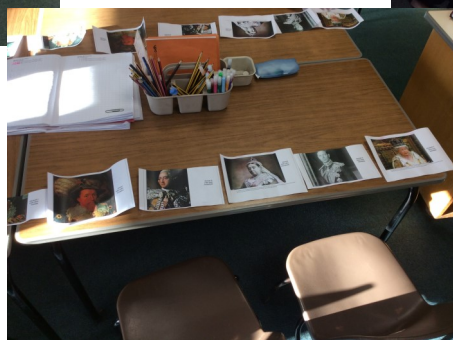
# YEAR 1
