




Great Moor Community Infant School



When I am in school I try to be caring to the grown ups and my friends.


One of my friends lost their school jumper.

things would be caring for the dog!




Sometimes it might be raining and I would be watching a T.V. programme, but I would still have to walk the dog.

Caring for places – the beach





I went to the beach in the holidays and Mummy and Daddy helped me build a sandcastle.
