This is **Caring Kabir**. He is one of our school values characters.

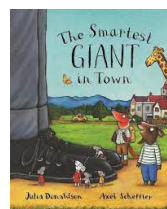
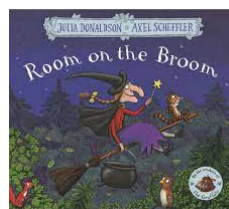

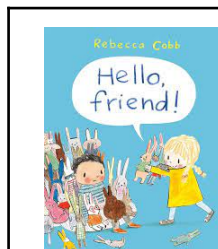
This half term we are sharing stories about how to be a caring friend like Kabir!

## All different, all equal

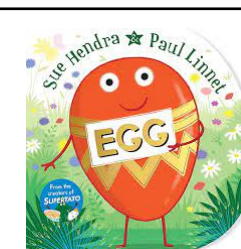
This is **Inclusive Isla**. She is another of our school values characters.

Building upon our learning last half term about our collective responsibility to keep our classroom tidy, we will begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things.

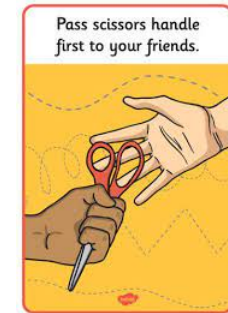
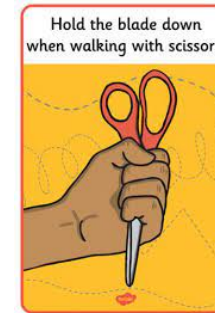
We will learn the tale of Stanley, a plastic bag who ends up being mistaken for a jellyfish when he is not disposed of correctly!
