<u>Maths</u>

Number - Place Value -

- counting, reading and writing numbers to 100
- finding one more and one less than a given number
- identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations

Number - Addition and Subtraction -

- add and subtract 1 and 2 digit numbers to 20
- use the + = symbols
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20

<u>English</u>

Begin to form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.

Saying out loud what they are going to write about.

Composing a sentence orally before writing it.

Sequencing sentences to form short narratives.

To write from memory, simple sentences dictated by the teacher.

Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words.

Read accurately by blending sounds in unfamiliar words.

Re-read these books to build up their fluency and confidence in word reading.

Foundation Subjects

Science

~ identifying, naming, drawing and labelling the basic parts of the

human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense

~ looking at and describing and name a variety of common animals (mammals).

Geography

~ using basic geographical vocabulary - shop, local area, town, city

~ participating in fieldwork - exploring the local area

 \sim identifying hot and cold places on the globe, thinking about Tom's route across the world

Art

~ looking at drawing techniques, using different media to draw on different materials and discussing and sharing ideas on which media is the best to draw or mark make on which material

~ looking at drawing familiar objects including houses and faces

History

~ comparing explorers from the past and the present

PE

~ outdoor games & gymnastics

PSHE

~ Keep / staying safe - school rules and road safety

RE

~ discovering further about Christianity and Christian's belief

Music

~ learning about pulse & rhythm (theme: all about me)

Computing

~ learning how to log on to the Cromebooks and exploring Purple Mash
