
YEAR 2

CLASS DOJO

We use Class Dojo as a way to promote positive behaviour within school. Each child has a cute avatar and points can be awarded to an individual child, a group or a whole class. Points are given for lots of reasons including working hard, being kind, tidying up and being an example of our school values. In Reception and Year 1, children start every day with 5 points, if they receive 10 points by the end of the day the teacher gives them a reward sticker. If they manage to achieve 15 points or more they visit Mrs Dobson and get a special Headteacher's Award sticker. In Year 2, points are cumulative in each term and children can earn special rewards such as wearing their own clothes for the day. See the table below for Year 2 rewards.



TENNIS CAMP
