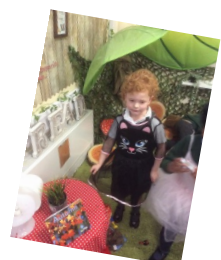
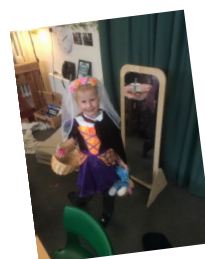
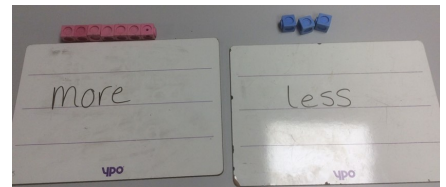


RECEPTION
